Belton Lake & Stillhouse Hollow Lake

Belton Lake has long been a Central Texas favorite for water sports, fishing tournaments, camping, picnics, or just relaxing. Fed by the Leon River, Belton Lake offers a haven for fishing and boating enthusiasts, covering 12,300 surface acres with 136 miles of shoreline.


Stillhouse Hollow Lake is rated among the highest of Texas lakes for water quality. Fed by the Lampasas River, it covers 11,830 Acres and includes 58 miles of shoreline. Along with water and outdoor sports, hiking enthusiasts will enjoy the Chalk Ridge Falls Nature Trail and its scenic waterfall.

Bell County Expo Center

From live music to championship rodeos, exciting motocross action and more, the Bell County Expo Center has it all. This multi-purpose entertainment and event complex was built in 1987, and is home to the Bell County Youth Fair Livestock Show and Rodeo, Central Texas State Fair, Belton Area Chamber of Commerce 4th of July PRCA Rodeo, Bell County Comic Con, conventions and countless concerts covering all genres of music.

The Dome Complex, one of the Expo's biggest draws, has arena style seating for up to 8,000 plus. The Equine/Livestock Complex is situated on the west side of the campus, adjacent to the existing Horse Barn and Exposition Building. The heart of the new Equestrian/ Livestock facility will be its 150' x 300' performance surface. Add in air conditioning, a general concourse for vendors, seating for 1000 patrons, along with an attached warm-up arena with stalls and pens, and the Expo Center's excellent location-it's a world-class combination!

Bell County Museum

The award-winning Bell County Museum is a vital resource of collecting and preserving the historical heritage of the Bell County region, from 13,000 years ago to the mid-1900s. Originally housed in the beautifully restored Carnegie Library Building constructed in 1904, a major expansion in 2006 provided an additional 10,000 square feet of space. Family fun programs and interactive exhibits make this museum a must-see.

The Gault Site

The Gault Site has been home to humans for over 13,000 years. Early people foraged the uplands and the stream valley, leaving behind stone tools and other archaeological finds. To date, the excavations have uncovered almost 2 million artifacts, some from the Clovis period. Bell County Museum is home to a permanent interactive exhibit featuring its discoveries and offers guiding walking tours.

The Musick, Alumni Center and Museum at the Parker House on the campus of University of Mary Hardin-Baylor is housed in the former president's home, now remodeled to showcase the rich heritage of the school. Exhibits include fourteen of the traditions loved by students and alumni along with chronological history of UMHB.

Police Memorial

As a program of the Chamber of Commerce, the Leadership Belton Class of 2016 raised funds, coordinated the design, and worked with contractors to construct a timeless mermorial and entrance sign for the Belton Police Department. This permanent structure not only welcomes visitors but honors all public servants who are retired or currently serving. The memorial pays tribute to the lone Belton officer, Deputy Albertus Sweet, who was killed in the line of duty in 1881. Visit any time of day or night.

University of Mary Hardin-Baylor

The University of Mary Hardin-Baylor was chartered in 1845 by the Republic of Texas and sits on 125 acres. The first building, simply called "The College," was built in 1886 but burned in 1929. The Luther Memorial Arches are the only evidence of that structure and are an important campus landmark today. Enjoy walking through this peaceful campus with its historic buildings and markers, native landscaping, many sculptures, and vibrant student spirit.

Bell County Historic Courthouse

Built in 1884-1885, the Bell County Courthouse is a prime example of Renaissance Revival architecture. Exterior characteristics of the style include a rusticated ground floor with Roman arches and monumental arcaded recessed galleries. The beautiful clock tower and goddess of justice statue provide an especially dramatic view at night.

Hike and Bike Trail at Nolan Creek

One of Belton's best hidden treasures runs along the banks of Nolan Creek. A natural beauty hike and bike trail where you can learn about the history of the famous Chisholm Trail by reading the storyboards provided. The trail connects several of the city's scenic parks.





Belton Lake Outdoor Recreation Area (BLORA)

Swim, sunbathe, and enjoy Belton Lake at Sierra Beach, BLORA's authorized swimming area. The swimming area is open Friday through Sunday throughout the summer season, pending availability of lifeguards. Two large water slides are located near the beach, and more than 300 family picnic sites and 143 covered picnic shelters are scattered throughout the park, many with barbecue grills. Mountain biking, horseback riding, RV camping, fishing, paintball and water sports are among some of the activities available. You can rent kneeboards, skis, wakeboards, paddle boats, kayaks, tubes, bikes, and camping equipment on site.

Summer Fun Water Park

Experience cooling family fun at this seven-acre water park. For a real splash, two 300-foot body slides and a 300-foot tube slide sends you twisting and turning from a 40-foot tower. Relax on the lazy river, test your strength swinging on the rings across the Texas-sized pool, or play a game of basketball or sand volleyball. Children will enjoy the kiddie pool, equipped with three slides. Concessions provide food and drink, and party facilities with covered pavilions are available for rental. You can also book the ENTIRE park for private parties!
